Our Programs

Project STARS

Our hallmark program gives low-income students at risk of dropping out of high school a pathway to success by making a college education a reality; all Project STARS scholars are assigned a mentor to guide them through their journey to higher education.

Academic A+

Allows organizations to recognize students in grades 4-12 who have overcome personal challenges.

First Generation

Awards scholarships to students attending a Florida College or University who will be the first in their families to achieve a college degree.

In-Demand Career

Allows organizations to recognize students who are interested in pursuing a career in high-demand fields.

Legacy

Allows organizations to recognize students who exemplify leadership through academic excellence and community service.



Other Scholarship Programs

We work with private donors like community groups, businesses, hospitals and religious organizations to provide privately funded scholarships for deserving students. Donors may establish their own award criteria and purchase scholarships with 100% private sector donations.
